SUBJECT: Agricultural Education major on the UGA Tifton campus

The College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences requests permission to offer the agricultural education major on the UGA Tifton campus. The major currently is offered on the Athens campus. We have received approval from Provost Mace to hire an agricultural education faculty member who would teach the required upper division agricultural education courses in Tifton. Agricultural education majors in Tifton would select their remaining upper division courses from among those currently offered by existing faculty as part of our agriscience and environmental systems (AES) major at Tifton. The Tifton-based agricultural education major would be upper division only, similar to the existing AES major.
