### **Current Drop/ Add Policy**

All students should have the opportunity to attend at least one class to decide if they would like to continue enrollment in that course.

Both drop and add periods begin on the first day of classes and extend through midnight of the 5th class day (business days). The drop-add period is the same for all courses and for all undergraduate and graduate students.

Students are responsible for all work assigned and material covered from the first day of class.

### **Proposed Drop/ Add Policy**

All students should have the opportunity to attend at least one class to decide if they would like to continue enrollment in that course.

For Fall and Spring semesters, both drop and add periods begin on the first day of classes and extend through midnight of the 5th class day (business days).

For summer semesters, the drop and add periods will be as follows:

For Extended and Thru session courses, both drop and add periods begin on the first day of classes and extend through midnight of the 5th class day (business days).

For May, first and second session courses, both drop and add periods begin on the first day of classes and extend through midnight of the 1st class day.

The drop-add period is the same for all courses and for all undergraduate and graduate students.

Students are responsible for all work assigned and material covered from the first day of class.
