



Dear Dean Anderson:

On behalf of the Department of Biochemistry & Molecular Biology, I wish to recommend for your consideration the termination of two degree programs: the M.S. in Biochemistry and the Ph.D. in Biochemistry. The department changed its name from "Biochemistry" to that of "Biochemistry & Molecular Biology" a number of years ago and simply failed to terminate the previous graduate degrees in Biochemistry. The Biochemistry degrees are no longer offered to majors as all receive degrees in Biochemistry & Molecular Biology, and thus the department recommends that these two degree programs be terminated. I have included completed and signed termination forms and will be happy to provide any additional information you and the Senate Curriculum Committee would like.


