The University Curriculum Committee met on October 20, 2023, at 3:30 p.m. in 327 Brooks Hall.

Minutes of the September 22, 2023, University Curriculum Committee meeting were approved.

A motion was made to consider all the action items on the agenda at once. The motion was seconded and approved. The committee then unanimously approved the following proposals, which were forwarded to the Executive Committee of the University Council for consideration:

- Proposal to change the name of the Graduate Certificate in Transformative Leadership to the Graduate Certificate in Complexity Leadership
- Proposal for a new minor in Sport Coaching
- Proposal for a new Undergraduate Certificate in Child Life
- Proposal for the following new certificates:
 - Undergraduate Certificate in Studio Furniture Design and Fabrication
 - Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Studio Furniture Design and Fabrication
- Proposal to offer the existing major in Education (Ed.S.) with an Area of Emphasis in Literacy Specialist online
- Proposal for a new online Professional Master of Accountancy (MPAcc)

The committee unanimously approved the proposal to change the name of the following area of emphasis under the major in Mathematics Education (B.S.Ed.):

- From: Area of Emphasis in Teaching Advanced Mathematics
- To: Area of Emphasis in Educational Studies in Mathematics Education

William Vencill, Associate Vice President for Instruction, gave the committee an update on the changes to the University System of Georgia General Education Core Curriculum. The USG changes are not expected to impact the General Education Core Curriculum at the University of Georgia.

The committee discussed the process for reviewing new courses and course changes which have variable credit hours. After much discussion, a suggestion was made to require variable credit course submissions include a statement about the number of required contact minutes and how those contact minutes will be assessed. The committee will continue this discussion at the next meeting.

The committee continued discussion about the review of courses in the CAPA course approval system, and which course change fields could be administratively approved by the Office of the Registrar. The committee will continue this discussion at the next meeting.
