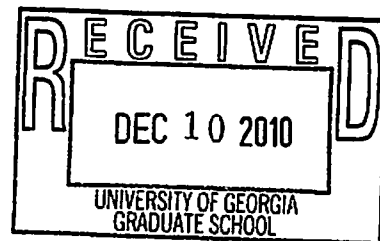

This program was offered by contractual arrangement for teachers in the Gwinnett County School District. After 2 cohorts of students completed the program, the school district's needs were met so we no longer offered the program. We failed to request termination at that time and are therefore requesting it now.

II. Conditions for Deactivating or Terminating Programs

The deactivation (temporary suspension) or termination (discontinuation) of programs is expected to address satisfactorily the conditions listed below in order to be approved and implemented within the University of Georgia. Please provide sufficient information to confirm each condition.

- 1. Provide copies of the studies and decisions that warrant deactivation or termination of the program.**
No studies were conducted that led to the termination of this program. This program was provided by contractual arrangement with the Gwinnett County School District and after 2 cohorts of students completed the program, the school district's needs were met so we no longer offered the program at that location.
- 2. State the reasons for deactivating or terminating the program.**

This program was offered on-site in the Gwinnett County School District for 2 cohorts of teachers at the request of the school district and with district funding to support instruction. Upon graduation of the second cohort in 2008, the district no longer had a need for the program, so it has been inactive.

- 3. State the plans for allowing those students already in a program to complete degree requirements.**
All students enrolled in the program graduated by Spring 2008. There are no more students in the program.
- 4. What will be done to minimize the impact of deactivation or termination of the program upon the personal and professional lives of the faculty involved?**
No faculty members are impacted by the closure of this program as we have added additional cohorts of students on the Athens campus that make up for the workload lost by terminating this program.
- 5. What will be done to insure that deactivation or termination of the program does not weaken other programs (graduate, undergraduate, or professional) for which the department may be responsible?**
We still offer this program at other locations (Athens, Griffin), so terminating the Gwinnett offering has no impact on other programs in the department.
- 6. What plans, if any, is there for subsequent reactivation or reinstatement, respectively, of the deactivated or terminated program?**
At this time there are no plans to reinstate this program. If there is an expressed demand in the future, we would follow procedures to offer the program on the University of Georgia Gwinnett Campus so that it would be available to graduate students from a wider geographic area rather than just restricting it to employees of the Gwinnett County School District.

8. Abstract of the deactivated or terminated program
This program was approved to be offered for teachers in the Henry County area. However, during the time we were recruiting students for this program, the University of Georgia Griffin Campus was opened, and we began offering the program at that campus, negating the need for the Henry County location. No students were ever admitted to or enrolled in the Henry County program. We failed to request termination at that time and are therefore requesting it now.

This program was never offered at the Henry County location because the Griffin campus became available before we admitted students to the Henry County location. The Griffin campus location provides a permanent location, office space for faculty, easy access to technology and office equipment/supplies, and other amenities that make the Griffin campus the preferred location for this program.

No students were ever admitted to or enrolled at this site. Instead, the program has been offered on the Griffin campus.

No students were ever admitted to or enrolled at this site.

No faculty members are impacted by the closure of this program because no students were ever admitted to or enrolled at this site.
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There are no plans to reinstate this program because an identical program now exists on the Griffin campus.
