The committee approved a request from the Division of Academic Assistance to change the credit awarded for UNIV 1105, Improving Grammar, Usage, and Style, from institutional credit to credit that may be used toward a degree.

The committee approved a request from the College of Education for Areas of Emphasis under the B.S.Ed. in Science Education. This request will be forwarded to the Board of Regents for information only.

The committee tabled a proposal for a School of Public and International Affairs until input could be received from affected schools and colleges.

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The committee approved revisions of entrance requirements for the following majors:
