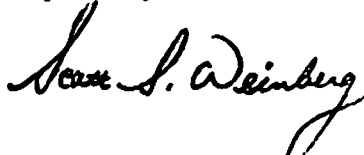
The committee approved a proposal for an Area of Emphasis name change under the Bachelor of Science in Biological Engineering.
