The committee approved a request for a new Area of Emphasis in Sustainable Agriculture under the major in Crop and Soil Sciences (M.S.).


The committee approved a request for a new Area of Emphasis in Educational Studies in Health and Physical Education under the major in Health and Physical Education (B.S.Ed.).
