The Hybrid and Online Teaching Subcommittee met on January 12, 2021, via Zoom.

The subcommittee discussed the Hybrid Suffix (Y) proposal draft and the details of the Y-suffix delivery mode.

The subcommittee discussed the next steps for the Hybrid Suffix proposal. It was recommended that the proposal includes a justification for the Y-suffix. Additionally, it was suggested that the proposal may also include wording about how the Y-suffix course information should be included in the course syllabus. This could mimic how the online information is included in E-suffix course syllabi. A shared drive will be setup for the committee to help facilitate collaboration on the proposal.

A timeline for drafting the proposal was discussed. The subcommittee would like to have an updated draft to review at the next scheduled subcommittee meeting. Once finalized at that meeting, the proposal will be submitted to the University Curriculum Committee meeting for consideration.
