The subcommittee unanimously approved the minutes of the November 27, 2023, General Education Subcommittee meeting.

The subcommittee unanimously denied the following courses to be added to list of courses approved to satisfy Area II, Life Science, of the General Education Core Curriculum due to the CAPA course objectives and topical outlines being too narrowly focused.

ENTO(BIOL) 2010, Insects and the Environment  
ENTO 2010E, Insects and the Environment

The subcommittee unanimously approved the following course to be added to list of courses approved, to satisfy Area IV, Humanities and the Arts, of the General Education Core Curriculum:

GRMN 3560, German Film and Visual Culture

This course was originally submitted to be considered for Area IV, World Languages and Culture and Humanities and the Arts, but the subcommittee determined GRMN 3560 would be better suited for Area IV, Humanities and the Arts.

The subcommittee unanimously denied the following course to be added to list of courses approved, to satisfy Area IV, for Humanities and the Arts, of the General Education Core

Curriculum due to insufficient evidence that the course meets the learning outcomes for this area:

EDUC 2140/2140E, Foundation of Reading
