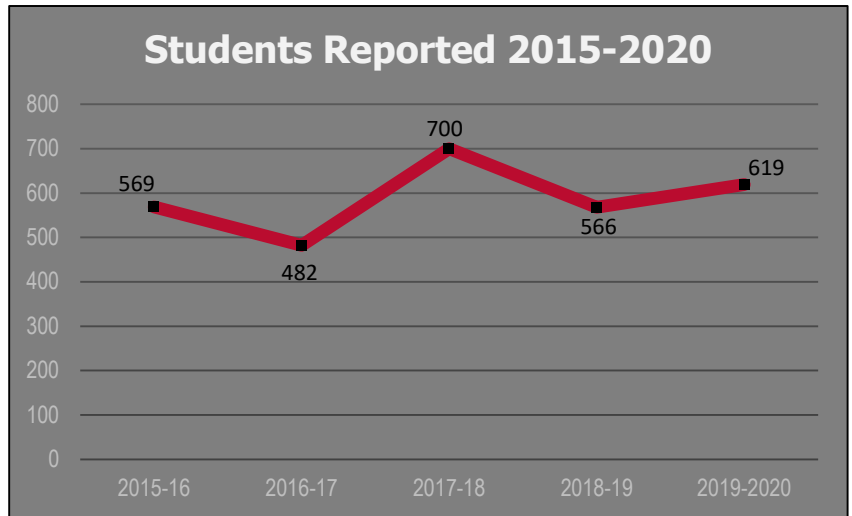


## Overview

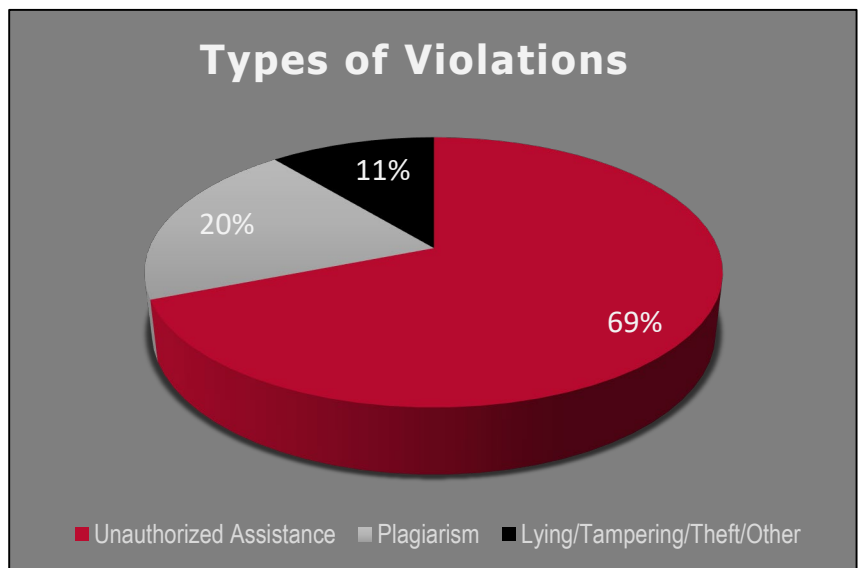
